Lumina 9000 Series

The OSHA Safety Data Sheet (SDS) requirement does not apply to Lumina 9000 Series since they meet the requirements of an article of manufacture as defined in OSHA Hazard Communication Standard, 29 CFR 1910. 1200. The definition of an article is given by OSHA in paragraph (c) of the hazard communication standard.

Article means a manufactured item other than a fluid or particle

1. Which is formed to a specific shape or design during manufacture.
2. Which has end-use function(s) dependent in whole or in part upon its shape or design during end use, and
3. Which under normal conditions does not release more than small quantities, e.g., minute or trace amounts of a hazardous chemical (as determined under paragraph (d) of this section [of the hazard communication standard] and does not pose a physical or health risk to employees.

Lumina 9000 Series are a manufactured product that will not release hazardous chemicals under normal use and handling conditions. Such articles are exempt from the OSHA hazard communication standard and do not require a SDS.
